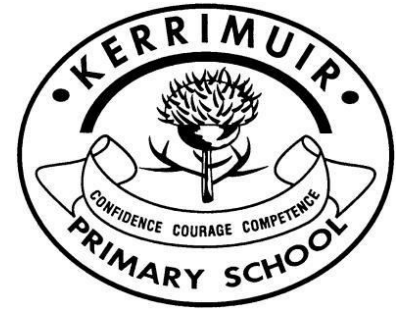

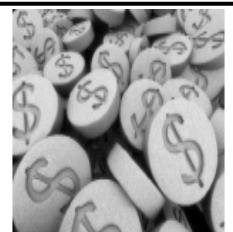

Request for donations of bottles of wine, spirits, port!!!

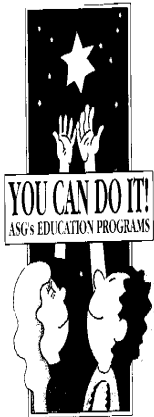

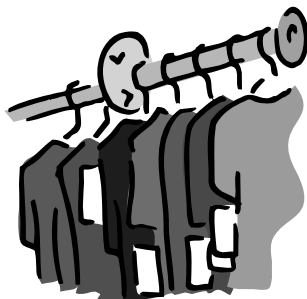
All monies raised will go towards our school's fundraising efforts to benefit the entire school community.
