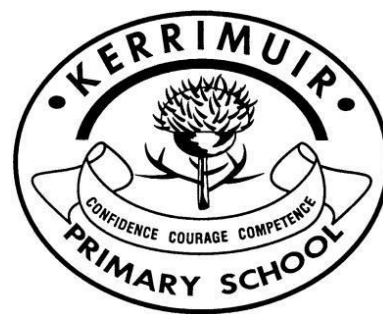

Interviews to replace Marg will be happening over the holidays.

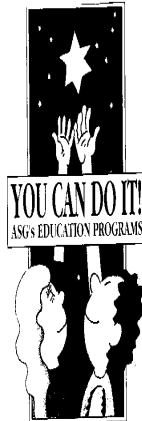

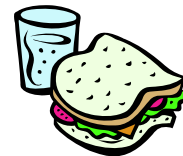

This unit is entitled Basic Engineering - Unit 1 using Lego Dacta. Through activities and exploring, children will develop their language, and explore mathematical and scientific ideas. Children will make working models each week. It helps all children develop skills and stimulates and encourages them to think on a higher level. This is a unit for all children, girls and boys and there are separate kits for the Juniors and Seniors. Seniors will be working with the idea of levers, structures and forces while the Juniors will be working with levers, wheels and axles - and it is absolute fun!

As part of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations, the Fundraising Committee would like to produce a cookbook to help commemorate the occasion.

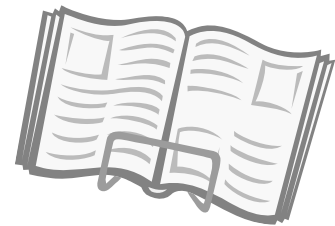
We would like YOU to provide a copy of your Family Favourite recipes.
