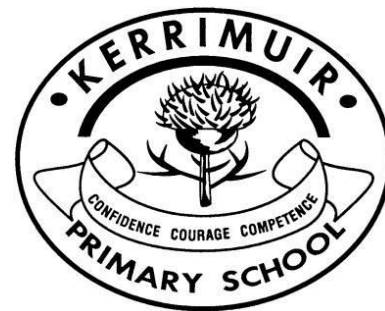

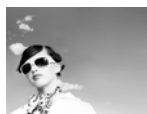

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT



Sunglasses at school and being

SunSmart

The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development and Sun Smart policies encourage children to wear sunglasses at school, especially in the summer months and on high UV days. Children are encouraged to wear close-fitting, wrap-around sunglasses that meet AS1067 (Category 2, 3 or 4), with marked EFP 10 protection. Fashion sunglasses not meeting this guideline will not provide protection adequate to prevent the nasty results of long term sun damage (which includes Cataracts, Pterygium and Solar Keratopathy).

The new SunSmart guidelines now include two additional extras to the Slip, Slop, Slap we have known for many years:

1. **Slip on some sun protective clothing**— that covers as much skin as possible
2. **Slop on SPF30+ sunscreen** – make sure it is broad spectrum and water resistant.
3. **Slap on a hat** – that protects the face, head, neck and ears
4. **Seek shade**
5. **Slide on some sunglasses** – make sure they meet Australian Standards

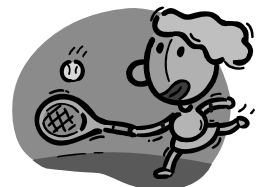
